

DRIVER TELEMATICS FOR DRIVER SAFETY




TELEMATICS

Mobile telematics refers to a range of products that keep track of a driver's data. This is recorded in an effort to identify trends that can then be turned into practical advice to encourage safer driving.

Telematics enable drivers to develop their skills and awareness behind the wheel. Telematics is used via a plug-in device connected to software installed on a smartphone via an app. This software monitors the driver's behaviour, including their everyday driving habits. The software provides feedback on driving behaviour after each journey, such as harsh breaking or coasting.

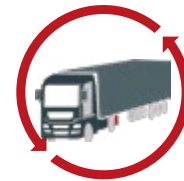

HARSH BRAKING

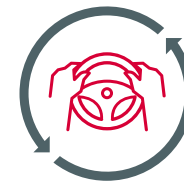
The concept of Harsh Brake Applications means how often the brake pedal has been used on average over 100km.

A brake application is regarded as harsh, if the vehicle speed falls by more than 9km/h in less than a second.



VEHICLE IDLING

Idling means that the power in the vehicle is switched on, the speed is lower than 4km/h and no power take offs are in use. Idling is registered if the vehicle is idle for more than 30 seconds.



VEHICLE COASTING

The concept Coasting (% of distance) means the percentage of the distance, the vehicle was driven without any fuel injection in the engine.

During this distance, the driver drove without touching the accelerator pedal. The vehicle or driver has not reached the traffic light target if the parameter coasting (% of distance) is a smaller proportion of the time than you specified as the target value.

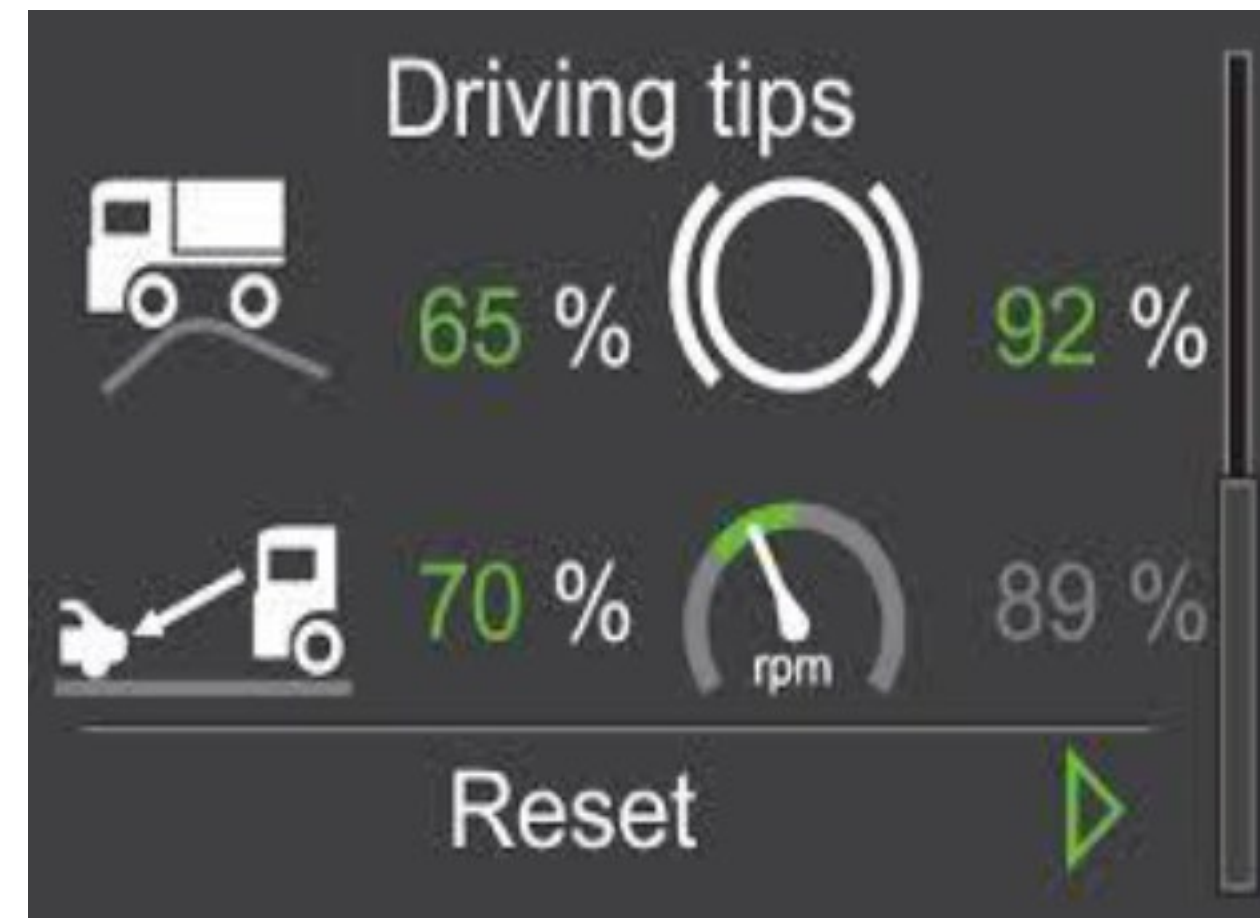




SCANIA DRIVER SUPPORT
